APPLICATION FOR INCENTIVE AWARDS FOR CLASS REPRESENTATIVES AND FOR AWARD OF ATTORNEYS' FEES AND EXPENSES RELATED TO CLASS SETTLEMENT WITH MANUFACTURER DEFENDANTS SMITTY'S AND CAM2

COME NOW PLAINTIFFS, by and through Class Counsel, and for their Application for Incentive Awards for Class Representatives and for an Award of Attorneys' Fees and Expenses Related to Class Settlement with Manufacturer Defendants Smitty's and CAM2 ("Application"), state as follows:

- 1. Plaintiffs/Class Representatives in this Action reached a Class Action Settlement and Release with the two Manufacturer Defendants ("Manufacturer Settlement Agreement") which makes available relief to thousands of Class Members who purchased "303" Tractor Hydraulic Fluid manufactured by Smitty's Supply, Inc. and CAM2 International, LLP during the Class Period ("303 THF Products").
- 2. The Manufacturer Settlement Agreement provides compensation payments to Settlement Class Members through a Class Settlement Fund of \$31,900,000.00 to be used to pay (a) claims of Qualified Settlement Class Members, (b) all settlement administration and notice costs, (c) all incentive awards to Class Representatives as Ordered by the Court; and (d) Class Counsel's attorneys' fees and expenses.

- 3. The Class Settlement Fund will provide each Qualified Settlement Class Member with an award that will be determined based on (a) the units of 303 THF Products purchased by each such Settlement Class Member during the Class Period; and, (b) the costs of any repairs, parts, and specific equipment damage that resulted from, in whole or in part, the use of the 303 THF Products during the Class Period.
- 4. In addition to the awards to Settlement Class Members, Manufacturer Defendants agreed in the Settlement Agreement to pay out of the Class Settlement Fund, if approved by the Court, an incentive award in the amount of (i) \$4,500 to each of the Class Representatives who provided deposition testimony as well as interrogatory responses and documents in discovery and (ii) \$3,000 to each of the Class Representatives who provided interrogatory responses and documents in discovery, but no deposition testimony. The names and amounts sought for each Class Representative are set forth on Exhibit 1. As further discussed in the supporting suggestions, the requested incentive awards for these Class Representatives are appropriate.
- 5. The Manufacturer Defendants also agreed in the Settlement Agreement to pay out of the Class Settlement Fund the amount of Class Counsel's Court-awarded litigation expenses and the amount of Class Counsel's Court-awarded attorneys' fees, up to \$12,760,000.00. Such a fee award represents a 40% contingency fee on the \$31,900,000.00 Class Settlement Fund. Class Counsel respectfully submits the amount agreed to and sought by this Application is fair, reasonable and justified given the complexity of the issues, the meaningful nature of relief obtained through this Settlement, and the significant amount of work required from Class Counsel. As set forth in Plaintiffs' suggestions in support, the lodestar cross check of this requested fee more than supports the award; in fact, there is no multiplier.

- 6. Class Counsel's requested expense reimbursement is also supported by the record. To achieve the settlement result for the Class, Class Counsel were required to engage multiple experts for class certification and merits issues, fund class notice in 8 states, and take and attend depositions and inspections in more than 8 states, in addition to the other expense categories reflected in the expense submission.
- 7. Class Counsel thus seeks reimbursement of Plaintiffs' reasonable litigation costs of \$1,716,535.05 and for Class Counsel reasonable attorneys' fees in the amount \$12,760,000.00.
- 8. In further support of this Application, Plaintiffs submit their Suggestions in Support.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs pray for an order of this Court approving (a) incentive awards of (i) \$4,500 to each Class Representative who provided deposition testimony as well as interrogatory responses and documents in discovery, and (ii) \$3,000 to each Class Representative who provided interrogatory responses and documents in discovery, but no deposition testimony; and (b) Class Counsel's expenses of \$1,716,535.05 and attorneys' fees of \$12,760,000.00.
