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**PLAINTIFFS’ MARCH 2026 INTERIM STATUS REPORT**  
**REGARDING SETTLEMENT ADMINISTRATION**  
**OF MANUFACTURER SETTLEMENT**

COME NOW Plaintiffs, by and through Class Counsel, and provide the Court the following Interim Status Report Regarding Settlement Administration.

1. The Court granted final approval for this nationwide class settlement on March 27, 2025. (Dkt. #1221). There were no objectors and no appeals. The Net Settlement Fund, after payment of Court-Ordered attorneys’ fees, litigation expenses, incentive awards, and anticipated settlement administration expenses, was \$16,664,479.47.

2. Pursuant to this Court’s July 7, 2026 Order (Dkt. #1230), the Settlement Administrator distributed \$16,182,532.98 (plus \$25,000.00 in pre-distribution claim corrections) to 5,241 claimants on July 29, 2025. As of March 16, 2026, distribution checks to 5,161 of those claimants have been cashed. There are 80 of these original distribution checks that remain uncashed for a total of \$12,425.90. Those original distribution checks are now expired. By phone and/or email, Class Counsel has attempted to reach each of the claimants whose original distribution checks remain uncashed. The Settlement Administrator has also mailed letters to each of the claimants who have uncashed original distribution checks.

3. Of the 80 uncashed and stale original checks noted in paragraph 2, there are presently 20 reissued checks which remain uncashed for a total of \$10,212.80. Many of these checks were recently reissued and mailed in early 2026 after Class Counsel reached the claimant and discovered the claimant had not received the original check in the mail.

4. Also pursuant to the Court's July 7, 2026 Order (Dkt. #1230), a contingency fund of \$481,946.49 was initially established for the payment of any late claim and any claim corrections. As of March 16, 2026, there have been 64 late claims and/or claim corrections paid for a total of \$485,536.02.

5. The Court's Preliminary Approval Order (Dkt. #1230) approved RG/2 as Settlement Administrator with a budget of \$992,790.00 for notice and settlement administration. RG/2 will be completing all notice and settlement administration for less than the budgeted amount approved by Court. To date, RG/2 has been paid \$886,131.65 for notice and settlement administration expenses and fees, with one additional payment of \$20,000 left to be made for handling/paying late claims, further settlement administration, final accounting and shutdown.

6. During settlement administration, interest totaling \$69,710.07 has been earned on the Settlement Fund.

7. As of March 16, 2026, the balance of the Manufacturer Settlement Fund, including the interest earned and less the amount due to RG/2, is \$157,965.68. This amount assumes that all outstanding distribution checks (original and late claims) are cashed.

8. After all checks are cashed and/or have become stale, Plaintiffs will submit a Final Status Report including the Post-Distribution Accounting Form as set forth in the Court's July 7,

2025 Order (Dkt. #1231).

WHEREFORE, as set forth above, Class Counsel submits to the Court this March 2026 Interim Status Report Regarding Settlement Administration of the Manufacturer Settlement.
